South Carolina Digital Collections has implemented four Regional Scanning Centers—in the Upstate, Midlands, Low Country, and Pee Dee—to assist institutions like yours that want to contribute their collections to the SC Digital Collections database. Potential contributors may seek digitization assistance from one of the regional centers: Clemson University, University of South Carolina, College of Charleston, or Coastal Carolina University.

Assistance at the regional centers includes project planning, scanning, metadata creation, loading to the database, and anything in between!

If you have an idea for a digital collection, please review our Collection Policy, and do not hesitate to contact us or submit a Project Proposal, available on our web site under “About Us.” All submissions will be considered. At SCDC, we consider each project to be unique, and will manage it as such.
